# Industry Lean Cluster

## Pilot Program:

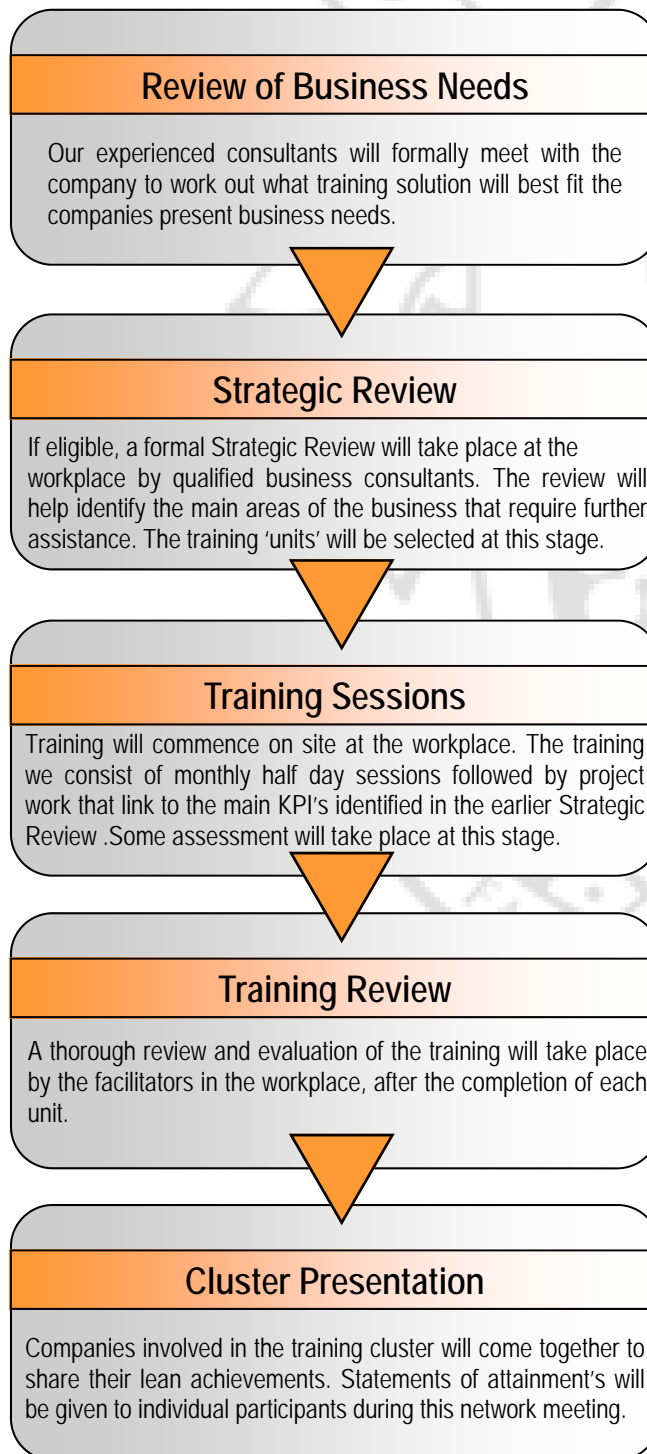
The Centre for New Manufacturing at Swinburne University are currently running a 'Lean Cluster' program for Small to Medium Enterprises in Victoria. This Pilot Program has been designed to promote lean philosophies into a business while focusing on their Key Operational concerns. In a 2 stage process, businesses will cover key lean tools and techniques such as visual management, 5s procedures, quick change overs, work standardisation and Just in Time. The training will be facilitated on site at the workplace allowing for minimum disruptions to production.

The structure of this customised Pilot Program allows companies to focus on their Key Business Objectives through on site improvement projects that will be facilitated by specialist continuous improvement consultants. This structure promotes a team building and staff mentoring approach to training, which will assist in the sustainability of the learning in the long-term.

Throughout the Pilot Program the participants will learn how to apply "Lean Concepts" to practical workplace situations and help develop a culture of 'continuous improvement' in the organisation. We will help your employees develop the skills that enable them to make decisions, problem solve and communicate effectively in a busy manufacturing environment.

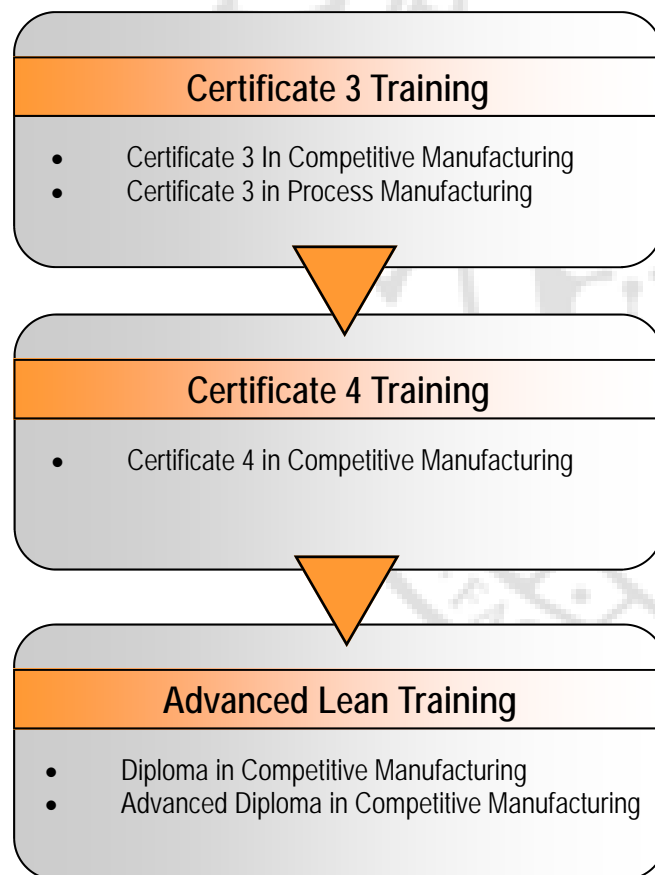
As learning 'Competitive Manufacturing' principles is a crucial element to the success of Victoria manufacturing, there may be funding incentives available to support your training project.
