

## Certificate IV in Training and Assessment (TAA40104)

<p>To continue to work as a trainer/teacher/assessor in a Registered Training Organisation (RTO) if I already have the <i>Certificate IV in Assessment and Workplace Training (AWT)</i></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ You are not required to upgrade if you are currently teaching/assessing unless your organisation requires you to. The <i>Certificate IV in AWT</i> is seen as equivalent to the new <i>Certificate IV in Training and Assessment (TAA)</i> for the purposes of meeting the minimum standard to train and assess in (RTOs)</li> </ul> <p>(NB. If you have not been using the qualification, for training, employers <i>may</i> ask for the new qualification from 2006.)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ However you may wish to upgrade for your own professional development.</li> <li>▪ In this case you may be eligible to apply for some RCC for your experience and previous qualifications.</li> </ul> <p><b>Recommended Action:</b> Email coordinator Colleen Maguire <a href="mailto:cmaguire@swin.edu.au">cmaguire@swin.edu.au</a> for further details of RCC</p>
<p>So I can do the <i>Diploma in Training and Assessment</i>.</p>	<p>You will need the 12 core competencies to meet the prerequisites for this Diploma. You may be eligible for some RCC for this and may also require some 'gap training'</p> <p><b>Recommended Action:</b> Email coordinator Colleen Maguire <a href="mailto:cmaguire@swin.edu.au">cmaguire@swin.edu.au</a></p>
<p>To get a training job in an RTO or TAFE</p>	<p>This will be the only course available to meet the minimum requirement to train and assess in a TAFE / RTO from 2006 so this is an excellent course to do if you wish to work in these areas.</p>

Reason	Response
I am a secondary/primary teacher who wants to work in TAFE or another adult Learning Organisation (I do not have the <i>Certificate IV in AWT</i> .)	This is the appropriate course to do.
